Commonly used horse care items include:

- Water troughs
- Stall waterers
- Mounted buckets
- Feed buckets
- Corner feeders
- Pasture feeders
- Salt licks
- Salt lick holders

Filling Feed and Water Items

Some care items need to be filled to be useful around your plot.

“ Feed Tip

Feed buckets, Feeders, and Salt Lick Holders can be filled using the **Feed Tool**.

“ Water Tip

Buckets, Stall Waterer, and Water Troughs can be filled using the **Hose Nozzle Tool**.

Where to Buy Feed

Best Uses for Plot Care Items

Placing care items thoughtfully can make your plot feel much more realistic and organized.

Some good places to use them include:

- Feed buckets in stalls
- Mounted buckets along stall walls
- Water troughs in paddocks or pasture areas
- Corner feeders in stalls
- Salt licks and salt holders in stalls or field shelters
- Pasture feeders in larger grazing spaces

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
